As a former teacher, I can tell you that students who do not read over the summer lose ground and skills. Teachers expect their students to lose some of the knowledge from the previous year, but many lose way too much. As summer is starting, students need educational opportunities so they can return to school strong and ready to learn more. This “slide” doesn't effect all students the same, but if your child is already struggling or has learning disabilities, a summer with no reading or math practice sets them up for continued failure.
