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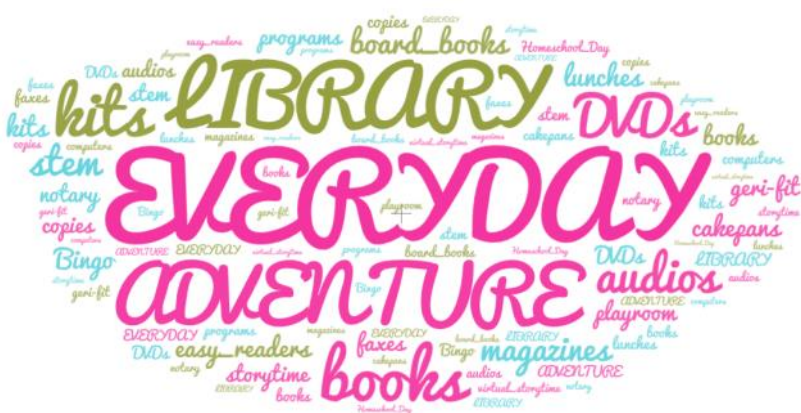

Everyday is an adventure at the library!

As I have been thinking and planning for 2024 programs, the theme “Adventure Begins at Your Library” really resonates with me.

Everyday is an adventure at the LIBRARY, might be a more appropriate theme. I definitely have learned over my nearly 45 years at the library is it is always an adventure. It may seem like a boring, humdrum place to be, and it could be if you let it. But doing things, planning programs, working with people and books are always exciting and always an adventure. When I come to work each day, I never know for certain what the day will bring. Will it be a fairly quiet day doing routine things? Or will it be filled with children’s laughter and excitement at a program? Or will it be an adult’s thank you for something we’ve done for them?

Things have changed over the years, but one thing remains the same and that is YOUR LIBRARY is here to provide you with what you need. It may be the newest bestseller that Chris ordered knowing you love that author, or a family DVD, or an audio book to read on your road trip to grandma’s house. It may be joining friends for exercise, lunch and fellowship as one of our seniors, or even special programs and BINGO on Thursdays. For the toddler, it’s a new “freeze dance” song at Toddler time, or a new toy in the toy room. For the preschoolers, Miss LaVeda has a lot of fun, learning activities at story hour. It might be the displays and bulletin boards that Miss LaVeda and Miss Angel do every month to keep our library looking festive. We continue to offer copies, color copies, computer and internet use

throughout the library using our devices or your personal devices. The first person in the door today needed to take advantage of our notary service, so like I said, you never know what the next adventure will be. The meal programs that we provide has been one of our greatest adventures that we have taken on, not sure how it would go and not sure where the funding would come from, but we have been blessed by our awesome community of donors.

We continue to develop and fine-tune programs that we offer and 2024 will be no exception. To start the year we are planning on doing a “passive” program called “Spice of the Month”. We are partnering with K-State Extension (Marais des Cygnes branch) and giving patrons the opportunity to use and sample spices that they may or may not be using currently. Rather than buy a big bottle and have it sit on the shelf, you will receive a sample bag along with two recipe cards from the extension office with suggestions for using that spice. Sign-up for the January Spice of the Month is underway and you can sign up and pick up your recipes and spice at the library on or after January 2nd, 2024. All we ask is that you try the spice and let us know what you think. It would be awesome if you could take a picture of the “dish” you cooked using the spice and share it with us.

We are planning a lot more adventures at the library, at your home and with our partners for 2024. One of those will be the Audubon Nature Adventure Packs which can be used to check out birds & more.


