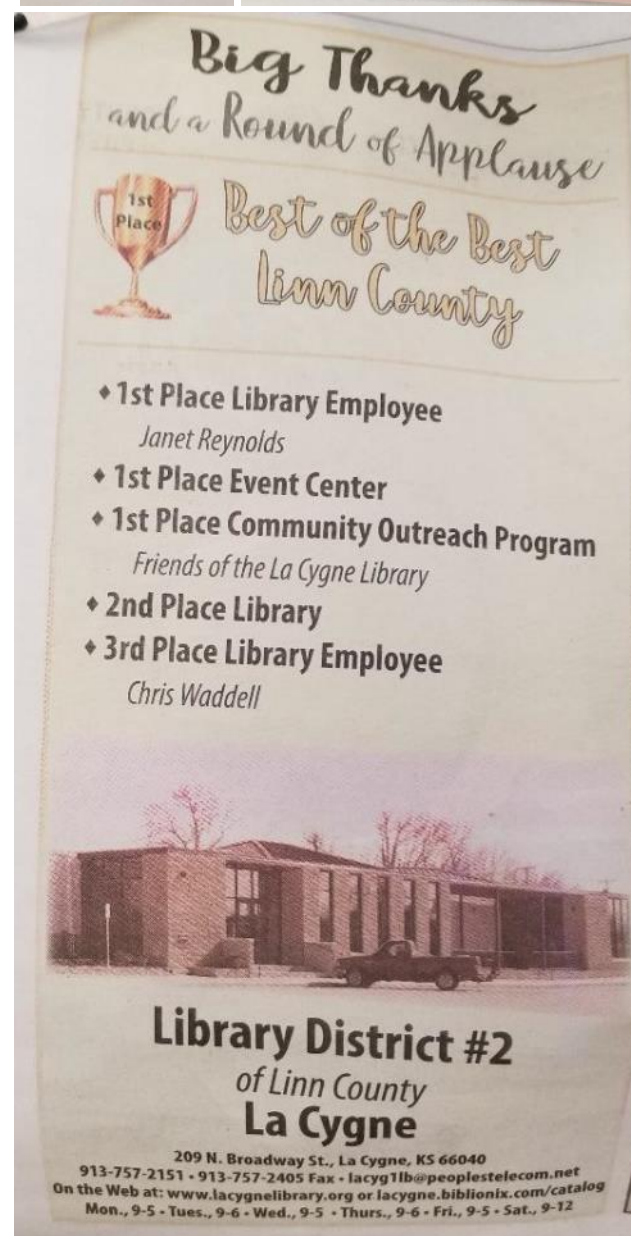

As our masthead says “Serving our community: one book, one program and one individual at a time!” That is our goal. We have books and magazines for folks just like libraries have always had, but we are so much more. We have cake pans, jigsaw puzzles, homeschool kits, birdwatching backpacks and audio books. We have computers, internet, WI-FI, faxes, color copies, email, and notary services. Even when the library is closed, we provide services like Hoopla, so you can read on your tablet or phone. We also have other databases you can access from our website www.lacygne.bibliionix.com/catalog. Look on the left hand side and see what we have you can use from home. We provide World Book, Hobbies & Crafts Reference Center, and My Heritage for your use in the convenience of your home. The State Library also provides 77 databases including Legal Collection, Mailbox Plus (for teachers and homeschoolers), MedLine for all your medical research, Auto Repair Source and several genealogy and history resources that can be used from home. And yes, even if you use them from home, they benefit our circulation because when you go in through our card catalog it lets us know that our patrons are using the resources.



But as you can see we also have a lot of other things like event and meeting rooms, community outreach programs (like senior lunch and summer lunch) and we collaborate with the museum, schools, and city/chamber to bring a lot of fun things to our community.

If you haven't visited YOUR library, please come in and visit us in 2025 and see what we have that YOU are interested in and that we can help YOU with. The library is here to help and benefit YOU, so come check it out.
