

Spin the Wheel is coming back again this summer! For children ages 2--6, for every 5 books you read, or have read to you, you get to spin the wheel and earn a prize from the wheel. Keep track of the number of books you read and each time you visit the library let us know how many new spins you get. For children ages 7 to 12, you get a ticket for every book you read, to put in a drawing for prizes to be given away the end of summer reading. The more you read the more chances you will have of getting your name in the drawing. So get busy reading!! Adults get a ticket for each book read or listened too, put your ticket in the drawing for the basket you would like to win. START READING!!!

Starting Monday, June 2, the library will be serving lunches at noon every day, except July 4.

There is no charge for the meals, but free-will donations are accepted. This program is made possible by concerned patrons and a few grant programs. **While there is NO COST to participate, we would like to encourage folks to stay for the programs at 12:30 each day.** The Mission of the library is to provide literary and educational programming and we have combined that with the lunch program. Each day we will have some activity at 12:30. On Mondays we will have a 30 minute game time at the lunch tables and maybe some music. On Tuesdays we have performers brought to us by the Baehr Grant from First Option Bank. On Wednesday we will have gardening one week and fitness the next week. On Thursdays we will have BINGO and you’ll play for candy. On Fridays we will have 30 minutes reading by volunteers and Free Book Friday. **PLEASE COME TO LUNCH AND PLAN TO STAY FOR THE PROGRAMS. WE WOULD APPRECIATE THAT VERY MUCH.
