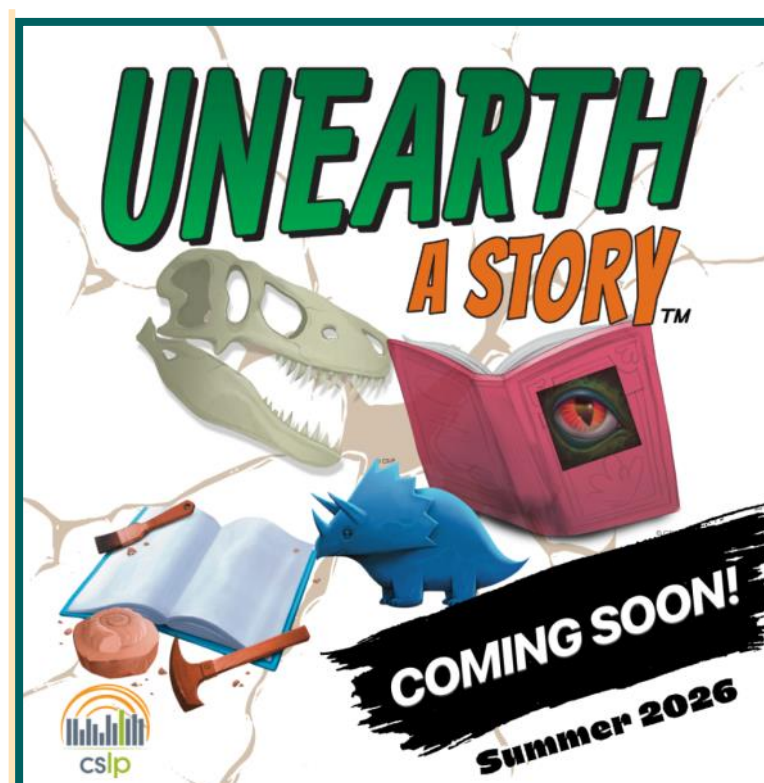

June 8-June 12 (Monday —Friday) 1 to 4 PM each day. This is for grades 3 through 6 just completed. Limited to 24 children. Please call to sign up as


Summer Camp #3 is brought to you by SEK Library System & Navigators!

This camp will be held June 29-July 2nd. It will start at 1 PM each day. It is focusing on students who have completed 3rd grade through 8th grade. It is a STEAM camp and will last until 4 PM each day. Again this is a limited number of participants, no more than 24 will be allowed to participate. We will be doing things with Scratch coding, robots, drones, tinker cad, 3-D printers, laser engravers, and more.


SEK Library system received a grant to purchase equipment to share in our area and they were able to hire “Navigators” who are trained to come help you learn these different technologies.
